#### 4. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This document is the Strategic Plan for the UCZ Muchinga Presbytery for the period 2023 to 2027. It was unanimously adopted by the Presbytery Executive Council which sat on 6<sup>th</sup> May, 2023 at the Presbytery Office in Mpika.

According to the SWOT Analysis the church in Muchinga has shown that it is doing quite well in some areas but that there is room for improvement even in areas where good work is being done. For instance, the human resource capacity is inadequate and so slows down progress, the financial base is weak, and infrastructure in most cases is run-down and inadequate while there is a hunger to take the Great Commission of Christ to higher heights so as to bring more people to the saving mercies of God.

To achieve the above aspirations, the church has to strive to bring people together, mode them to be partakers in the necessary changes and move along with them employing the modern technologies that are at hand. This entails rigorous nurturing of the present membership and that which is coming with the help of deliberately tailored capacity building techniques. Additionally, the present status-quo on finances should change from mostly wanting, to self-adequacy through engagement in various fundraising ventures if the church is to be able to perform well in the difficulty economy at hand.

#### **5.1: INTRODUCTION**

The Strategic Plan hereby written is for Muchinga Presbytery for the period January 2023 to December 2027 and its estimated budget stands at **ZMK35**, **449**, **999.00**. The Presbytery consists of 12 Consistories and these are coordinated from Mpika where the Presbytery Office is located.
